Sundogs prove Planet X is "Fake News

- Venus rises before Sun- on Friday May 10th just after 5:00 am look NEE as the morning star rise
- 2. Mars & M35 Open Cluster Conjunction- on Sunday, May 19th after dusk look NWW as these 2set around midnight in the NW.
- 3. Waxing Crescent Moon in Beehive cluster- On Friday May 10th, you can check these out after dusk into the night.
- 4. Eta Aquarids Meteor Shower- caused by comet 1P Halley shoots 15-20 meteors per hour after Saturday evening May 04th and before dawn on Monday the 06th. The New Moon makes for perfect skies in the Constellation Aquarius (SEE).
